This new organization will play a pivotal role in ensuring that the sewer installation process moves forward efficiently and effectively. This achievement is a testament to the community's hard work, dedication, and collaboration to address the wastewater management needs of the area. Patrons elected Tim Brown, Mariah Patel, Daniel Singleton, Guy Vernon, and Kristin Yurdin to the Board of Directors. Their terms of board service officially began on July 1, 2023.

Project Updates

- The District has applied to Oregon DEQ Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) for the majority of project funding, including a \$2 million project grant. The project team is currently navigating federal permitting requirements.
- The finalized Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) between the District, City of Redmond, and Deschutes County establishes the City of Redmond's provision of sewer treatment services to the District.
- A \$500k funding application has been submitted to the Business Oregon Water/Wastewater Fund, with a request for \$250,000 in the form of a grant.
- The District has sought \$2.5M federal grant funding from Representative Chavez-DeRemer and Senators Merkley & Wyden.
- An Annexation Policy has been adopted by the District, offering a free Annexation Application until April 30 for property owners interested in annexation this year.
- Final sewer design and permitting are underway, aiming to secure funding by the end of 2024 for contractor bidding.
- Following a temporary pause, the ODOT project is now progressing and will be open for bidding in April-May. Sewer infrastructure within the ODOT project area will be integrated into the roadway project.
